Cost: Trainings are \$5 per session, unless otherwise stated. On-site/private trainings start at \$10.00. For every five trainings you attend, you will receive one \$5 training for free. The free training(s) must be used before the end of the current fiscal year: June 30, 2022.

Location: All trainings will be held virtually and/or at Richmond County Chamber of Commerce at 505 Rockingham Rd, unless otherwise posted. A zoom link will be sent out the day of the training.

Certificates: Certificates will be available after the participant completes the surveys at the end of trainings. Virtual participants can call to pick up certificates or schedule a delivery.
