Request: If you are in need of a training not on the schedule, please contact us to see if we can accommodate your need or help you find the training. All trainings with our Child Care Health Consultant need to be requested through RCPC.



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Registration: To register for training, please fill out the information below and return it to our office. You can also fill out the form on our website. The registration deadline is the Friday before the class. (Ex. If a class is on Thurs., Jan. 20th, registration is due Fri., Jan. 14th).

Cost: Training is \$5 per session unless otherwise stated. On-site/private training start at \$10.00. For every five trainings you attend, you will receive one \$5 training for free. The free training(s) must be used before the end of the current fiscal year: June 30, 2023.

Location: All trainings will be held virtually and/or at Richmond County Chamber of Commerce at 505 Rockingham Rd, unless otherwise posted. A zoom link will be sent out on the day of the training.

Certificates: Certificates will be available after the participant completes surveys/evaluations and payment is received. Virtual participants can call to pick up certificates or schedule a delivery.

Disclaimer: Trainings are subject to change. A training may be canceled due to severe weather, low attendance, illness, etc. If a class is canceled, any payment will be credited to a future training. If a registered participant cannot attend, please contact RCPC as soon as possible. A credit or refund is at discretion of RCPC.
